



PS Murray Princess is a true inland paddlewheeler built for the Murray River. Catering to just 120 passengers, she brings the unique advantages of small ship cruising to the Australian outback. 3, 4 & 7 Night cruises depart weekly from Mannum with scenic coach transfers available from Adelaide.

Facilities

Two spas, two saunas, sun deck; two bars, two lounges, single-sitting dining saloon; speed boat; gift shop, library and video; lift; guest laundry and 24-hour tea and coffee facilities.

Accommodation

60 cabins and staterooms each with private bathroom ensuite, adjustable air-conditioning, electric blankets, soaps, shampoo and towels; serviced daily. Each cabin is approximately 12 sq metres.

- Staterooms open onto the outside deck and have a fridge and tea and coffee making facilities. All staterooms have a double bed.
- Outside Cabins open onto an outside deck and have picture windows.
- Inside Cabins open onto an inside passageway and have portholes facing the outside.




Dining aboard Murray Princess includes delicious blend of buffet and table d'hôte dining.


Stateroom Outside Cabin
