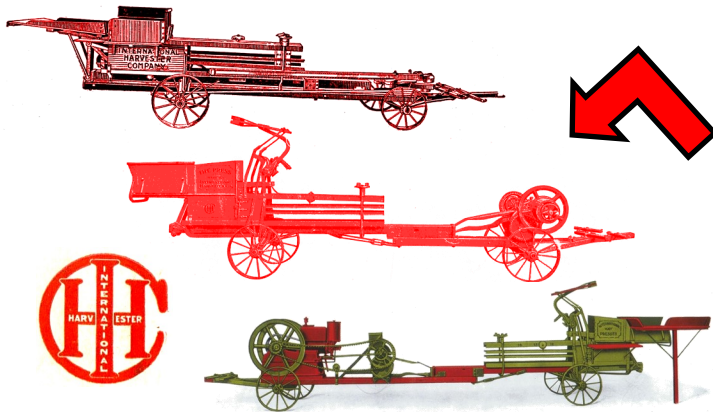


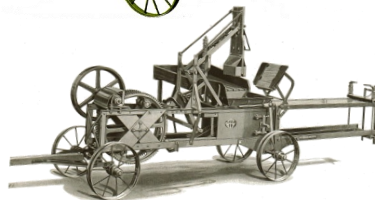
# First Ever I-H Historic Baling Festival to be at Thyra; Easter 2015; April 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>

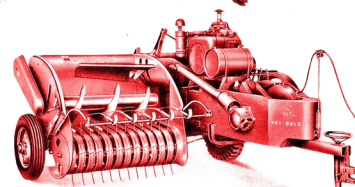
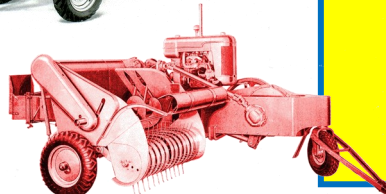
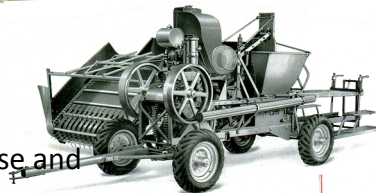
Every model International Harvester small square baler that ever baled in Australia, on site, in working condition and demonstrated.
