


FAMILY WINEMAKERS

Erin Harrald grew up in the Mid-North of South Australia in Hamley Bridge and Pinery. She moved to the Riverland in 2010 and fell in love with the community, natural beauty and country life. Erin became addicted to ceramics in 2001 when she started her Bachelor of Visual Arts, majoring in ceramics. After completing her degree, she spent two years at Jam Factory Contemporary Craft and Design as a design associate in the ceramics department. There she was trained and mentored by professionals in the industry in wheel throwing, decoration, firing kilns and running a pottery business. She won a scholarship in 2008 to spend two months in an international artist residency in Jingdezhen, China, a famous pottery town. She has creating pottery ever since! Erin's work is generally made on the pottery wheel and is brightly coloured and cheerful. Usually functional, she often makes bowls, mugs, beakers, platters, teapots, plant pots, tea bowls and grater plates. She also makes sculptural work and jewellery. Many pieces are uniquely Australian and inspired by our beautiful flora and fauna. Erin has recently moved the Winkie, where she works from her home studio. She teachers both adults and children in wheel throwing and hand-building techniques and love sharing these skills with others.
