

Goolwa to Farwell Boats on Historic Voyage

A flotilla of Paddle steamers and river vessels will be departing Goolwa on Sunday the 10th of August as a part of a commemorative voyage to mark the 150th Anniversary of Captain Francis Cadell's maiden voyage up river in 1853. This journey departing on the 25th of March 1853 indicated the commencement of shipping on the Murray River and the use of the river as a trading route.

A series of events and activities are being planned to take place in each of the towns as the vessels make their way up river. The events and festivities will culminate at Swan Hill on the 17th of September. Due to the water levels the vessels may however only be able to get to Mildura (see schedule below).

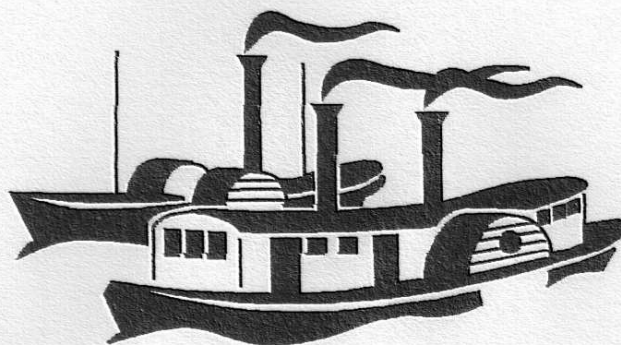
A program of activities are being planned at Goolwa to farewell the paddle steamers. There will be a performance by a local theatre group "The Muddy River Players" a formal welcome and farewell by the Mayor of Alexandrina Council Kym McHugh and series of paddle steamers and river craft on display prior to their departure around 1pm.
